Young Investigator Award

The *Young Investigator Award* has been initiated by AREMS in order to recognize the contributions of exceptional and distinguished young scientists from our region.

This competition is open to researchers and faculty members who have demonstrated expertise in the use of microscopy as a significant tool in their area of research and are less than 40 years of age on January 1st of the award year.

Outstanding faculty and researchers may qualify for this award through nomination by an AREMS member by submission of a letter of recommendation. Support from a second AREMS member in the form of a letter of recommendation is also required. In addition, eligible candidates must describe their work at the Annual AREMS meeting during a 20 minute oral presentation.
